\*\*\*<u>Vendors</u> will need to set-up BOTH days and break down on Saturday evening as nothing can be safely left outdoors overnight.

## Faire ends at 4:00 on Saturday & 4:00 on Sunday.

Unless you have an emergency or other special situation, **we ask that your booth remain set up until the end of each day**. When booths disappear from the vending circle, it leaves a hole, both physically & energetically, we want a cohesive circle & space for the benefit of all. Please be prompt, & ask customers to do the same.
